What did BI stand for? Business intelligence (BI) consists of strategies and technologies used by enterprises for the data analysis and management of business information.

What does a BI symbolize? While the prefix “bi” may literally mean two, bisexuality does not mean attraction to only two genders. For many bisexual people, the “bi” indicates an attraction to their same gender as well as other genders.

Who invented BI? The first use of the term “business intelligence” is widely attributed to Mr. Richard Miller Devens, in his book Cyclopædia of Commercial and Business Anecdotes, first published in 1865.
