ENGLISH THE AMERICAN WAY

What is American way of life in English? The "American Way of Life" is humanitarian, "forward-looking", optimistic. Americans are easily the most generous and philanthropic people in the world, in terms of their ready and unstinting response to suffering anywhere on the globe.

Why does American English sound the way it does? Within the span of just a couple generations, dialect leveling can change the sound of a population very noticeably. The American accent was thus a dialect leveling of a number of different British dialects. In addition to that, though, was the influence of people from all over the world.

What is the concept of American English? The term American English (or North American English) refers broadly to the varieties of the English language spoken and written in the United States and Canada. More narrowly (and more commonly), American English refers to the varieties of English used in the U.S.

How to understand the American English?

How to speak English like an American?

How is American English different? The most significant differences between British and American English are in their pronunciations, their vocabularies, and their spelling. There are grammatical differences, too, but these are less important and harder to describe, so we will pass over them for today.

Why did Americans lose the British accent? The first is isolation; early colonists had only sporadic contact with the mother country. The second is exposure to other languages, and the colonists came into contact with Native American languages, mariners' Indian English pidgin and other settlers, who spoke Dutch, Swedish, French and Spanish.

Why did Americans drop the U in words? Whereas British dictionary compilers opted merely to record established usage (which tended to favour French-looking words, hence the superfluous 'u'), early American dictionary compilers, notably Noah Webster, felt that simplifying the spelling - such as 'color' or 'meter' - would aid literacy and create a distinct ...

What American accent is closest to British? The Southern American English accent is closest to standard British English (RP, or "Received Pronunciation"). This is because many in the American South came to America directly from England.

Is American English closer to Old English? Studies on historical usage of English in both the United States and the United Kingdom suggest that spoken American English did not simply deviate away from period British English in some ways, but is conservative in other ways, preserving certain features contemporary British English has since lost.

What is an example of American English? French fries/fries (American) vs. chips (British) cotton candy (American) vs. candyfloss (British) apartment (American) vs. flat (British) garbage (American) vs. rubbish (British)

What is American English style? all take periods after them. Avoid words like “shall” and “needn't”; Americans tend to use “should” and “do not need” Collective nouns are always singular. Americans go “to the hospital” and “on vacation” A lot of slang is region specific, but check out a slang dialect glossary for some help.

How do you say hello in an American accent?

What are the rules of American English?

How difficult is American English? Most English language learners will find it challenging to learn English verb tenses, phrasal verbs, articles, spelling, pronunciation, and idioms. This is because these are features of English that are very different from most other languages in the world, or which simply require a lot of memorization.

How do Americans pronounce words? The three most distinctive consonants are R, the American middle T, and the Th sound. The R is a consonant, but it acts more like a vowel, because the tip of the tongue doesn't touch anywhere in the mouth. The middle T is what makes a word like meeting sound like meeding.

How can I be polite in American English?

How can I speak well American English? Practice and correction will improve your accent. And it doesn't have to be hard or boring. Watching a lot of YouTube videos, movies, and TV shows, for instance, is a great way to hear American accents. Talking to native speakers and asking them to correct you can be helpful too.

Why do British add r to words? It is to link the two vowels. You usually only hear this when the next word begins with a vowel, and the right vowel and the right stress for insertion to happen. As for why, the main reason is that syllable-final vowels are not phonemically meaningful for speakers of non-rhotic dialects.

What is the difference between American English and Canadian English? You may notice that Canadian English prefers to use “ou” in words like “humour” and “behaviour” as well as flipping the American use of “er” to “re” in certain words like “theatre” and “centre.” Canada isn't alone in preferring these spellings. British spellings of these words are taught across most of the world.

What makes American English unique? The differences between American and British English are mostly a matter of usage, and relate to differences in spelling, vocabulary, and idiomatic expressions—and, of course, pronunciation. However, there are some minor grammatical differences as well that most people don't notice as grammatical differences.

What is the lifestyle of an American? Americans who respect the rights of other citizens are free to work, play, worship, travel, and live as they please. Family - American families are small by comparison to many of the world's cultures. The average American family has 2 or fewer children. Most American children live in two parent households.

What are the concepts of life in America? The importance of a person being able to mold their own identity and future via their own choices, abilities, and efforts is heavily emphasized in American culture,

education, and institutions. Americans value taking care of themselves and having the freedom to pursue their own definition of happiness.

How would you describe American English? While written American English is largely standardized across the country and spoken American English dialects are highly mutually intelligible, there are still several recognizable regional and ethnic accents and lexical distinctions.

What is our American culture? American culture includes both conservative and liberal elements, scientific and religious competitiveness, political structures, risk taking and free expression, materialist and moral elements.
