Acing calculus gives your college app a competitive edge, but colleges' reliance on calc is problematic.

Is 50% a 3 on the AP test? Is there a break in the AP Stats exam? The Multiple-Choice section has 40 questions and you'll have 1 hour and 30 minutes to complete it. This is followed by a brief break, and then you'll move on to the Free-Response section, which consists of 6 questions and also allows for 1 hour and 30 minutes of response time.

What is the hardest part of statistics? As previously discussed, the hardest part of statistics is figuring out how to approach each problem. Once the correct logic is understood and correct formulas are selected to

answer a certain problem type, the actual math computation is relatively easy and involves basic algebra and calculator skills.

What is considered the hardest AP test? What Is the Hardest AP Class? Looking at the numbers, the hardest AP test is Physics 1. In May 2022, just 43.3% of test-takers passed, and only 7.9% received a perfect score. Other hard AP exams include US History, Macroeconomics, Chemistry, and Calculus AB.
