Within minutes, power was out from eastern Canada to Michigan and Ohio, on to Pennsylvania, New York, New Jersey and up into New England.

How many people died in the NYC blackout 2003? During the blackout, total mortality rose 28%, resulting in approximately 90 excess deaths (Figure 1, Table 1).
